6. Discuss and/or approve the 100th Judicial District Attorney's office records management and retention program. – Scott Sherwood

8. Discuss and/or approve the Meals and Incidental Expenses related to Travel specified by IRS for 2017. – Denise Salzbrenner, Treasurer

10. Motion to dismiss.
